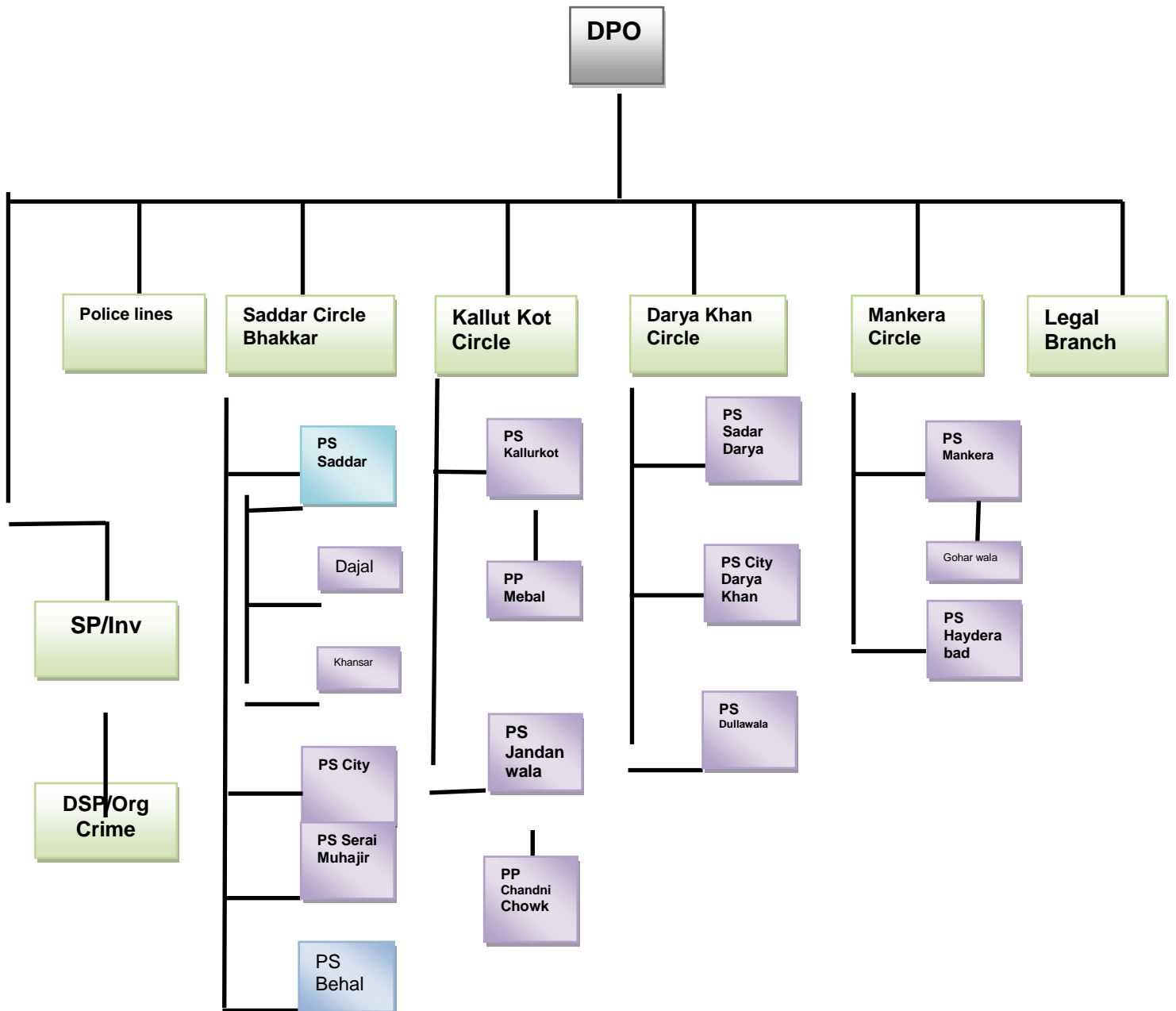
2.2 VAST RIVERINE BED (KATCHA)

The boundary of this District with D.I. Khan (N.W.F.P) consists of vast riverine bed (Katcha) spreading over an area of 100 Kms in a length and 20 Kms in breadth starting from Kallurkot and is stretched till Behal. River Indus flows through the western side of the District. This River has many ferries and passages on both sides. These routes are used by the POs, criminals and smugglers for trafficking of Narcotics, weapons and commission of heinous crime. The inhabitants of this area provide them full cooperation and accessories of life, either due to fear or connivance. Further routes adjoining the Districts of N.W.F.P are used for trafficking of weapons and narcotics. Criminals belonging to these areas also use these routes after committing offence especially in the area of Police Stations Kallurkot, Saddar Darya Khan and Saddar, Bhakkar.

POLICE ORGANIZATION IN THE DISTRICT.

District Bhakkar consists of 4 Sub-Divisions, i.e. Sadar, Darya Khan, Kallurkot and Mankera. There are 11 Police Stations and 5 Police Posts.

General review of the state of policing under Major Heads.

➤ **Terrorism**

Terrorism has become the major threat in the country in the present scenario. By the grace of GOD, during the previous last three years no Bomb Blast/ Act of Terrorism took place in this District.

➤ **Murder.**

During the year, 2015, 49 cases of Murder were registered as compared to 51 cases registered during the year, 2014 with decrease of **2**.

➤ **Dacoity**

During the year, 2015, 8 cases of Dacoity were registered as compared to 11 cases registered during the year, 2014 with decrease of **3**.

➤ **Robbery**

During the year, 2015, 54 cases of Murder were registered as compared to 47 cases registered during the year, 2014 with increase of **7**.

2.1.1) MAINTENANCE OF PUBLIC ORDER

- ❖ Sectarian sensitivity of the District due to 115 KM adjoining boarder with D.I. Khan (Khyber Pakhtoon Khaw) and also boundary with Jhang District.
- ❖ Bhakkar is one of the sensitive Districts of Punjab regarding sectarian issues, previous history of sectarian killings since 1981.
- ❖ Kidnapping for ransom also took place occasionally in District Bhakkar.

The maintenance of law and order is also foremost duty/responsibility of the police. The following action /mechanism on the part of police is proposed:-

- ❖ Police belonging to different organization, i.e religious, political and professional should be kept under close watch.
- ❖ Legal action should be taken against person involving in funding for defunct organization.
- ❖ Police should keep close vigilance over the activities of activists of defunct organizations.

2.1.2 COMBATING TERRORISM

No doubt terrorism has become a major threat throughout the country. Incidents of Bomb blast, suicidal attacks and target killings are being increased day by day in the country. Now a days, the terrorist are targeting the Security Forces and innocent people. The prevention as well as early detection of previous incidents of terrorism is dire need/object of the Police Force as well as the other law enforcing agencies of the country. To achieve this target in an effective manner, the following strategy is suggested:-

- ii) The activities of the persons borne on 4th Schedule, ATBs, RAPs and IMEs should be kept under close watch and they should be thoroughly interrogated so as to know indulgence of any of them in the previous incidents of terrorism.
- iii) God-forbid, if any terrorism incident takes place in any part of the country, modern devices and scientific techniques must be utilized during the course of investigation to trace out the real culprits and network thereof.
- iv) Training of weapon handling, musketry and fire practice should be imparted to each and every police officer/ official to tackle/handle the situation.
- v) Specialized and skilled police officers should conduct the sensitive/heinous cases so that the said I.Os with their experience may be able to bring on record solid and un-rebutable evidence to connect the accused with the crime because it has been observed that the culprits involved in such like offences usually take the benefit of defective investigation and lack of

credible/trustworthy evidence. Similarly, the prosecutors play a significant role in the successful prosecution of such like cases and to achieve the goal of sentence / conviction, it is considered essential that the prosecutors should also be given training for the purpose.

2.2 FOOLPROOF SECURITY MEASURES TO SAVE WORSHIP PLACES, KEY INSTALLATIONS AND OFFICIAL BUILDINGS

Foolproof security measures must be adopted to save worship places, key installations and official buildings and for safety of these installations, the below mentioned action is suggested:

- ❖ Administration of Masjid should be persuaded to arrange their security guards in addition to the police personnel deployed for security purposes.
- ❖ One gate of the Masjid should be used for entry/exit purpose.
- ❖ Parking place should be arranged with a proper distance from worship place.
- ❖ Metal detector should be provided for checking.
- ❖ Bunkers should also be set up at various points.
- ❖ Entry points should be properly barricaded and concrete barriers should be placed in the shape of Zig-Zag.
- ❖ All Encroachments should be removed from these places within 250 yards.

2.3 FREE REGISTRATION OF CASES:

- ❖ Registration of the FIR without delay is ensured.
- ❖ All SDPOs and SHOs have been directed to register the case without any delay when they received information about cognizable offence.

2.4.1 FAIR AND SPEEDY INVESTIGATION:

- ❖ I.Os are directed and trained to conduct investigation on merit and within due period of time.
- ❖ During inspections of Police Stations all the complainants of the cases are personally heard and justice is ensured.
- ❖ Every case is closely supervised by the SDPOs concerned.
- ❖ It is compulsory for the I.Os that all cases are forwarded by the SDPOs concerned before submitting to court.
- ❖ Open door policy for any grievance during the investigation.

- ❖ Through DSP/Legal all the decisions of courts are monitored.
- ❖ Strict departmental action is taken if fair investigation is not done.
- ❖ All SHOs have been directed to submit reports u/s 173 Cr.P.C within stipulated period prescribed in section 173 Cr.P.C.

2.4.2 IMPROVEMENT IN QUALITY OF INVESTIGATION

1. Scene of the crime is preserved and special team of CRO visits important crime scenes for scientific investigation.
2. Training and refresher courses have been started.
3. A mock exercise of case file writing is being done.
4. It is ensured that case diaries are being written by I.Os themselves.
5. Check list is pasted on every case file before sending to the court and closely scrutinized by SDPOs.
6. Counseling session of I.Os are made to make sure that they remain just and fair in their dealing with the public.
7. Modern investigation Kits have been provided in all Police Stations.
8. Advance TA and cost of investigation is given at every level but funds in the cost of investigation are insufficient.
9. Head proficient is posted in every circle with finger prints equipments and cameras for assisting the I.Os.

Technical Assistant Unit is established in DPO office to assist the I.Os in Mobile Forensic.

2.4.3 PROSECUTION OF HEINOUS CASES (Suggestions)

- ❖ New challan checking proforma has been prepared for removal of defects.
- ❖ Prosecution department is attached in the training of I.Os for effective prosecution and coordination. An Inspector is posted as senior Parvi Officer who's office is in District court premises, who ensures all the witnesses in the courts and looks after heinous cases prosecution.
- ❖ Criminal Justice Coordination Committee forum is used to highlight the prosecution of heinous cases.
- ❖ Action may be taken against Resiling Witnesses u/s 213 PPC
Strict action may be taken against the sureties u/s 514 Cr.P.C

2.5 PREVENTION OF CRIME.

It is primary duty of the police to protect the lives as well as properties of general public. In order to efficiently and successfully achieve this target, the following action on the part of police is suggested.

1. Effective patrolling should be ensured for prevention of crime especially crime against person and property. To effectively control the crime against persons, timely preventive action should be taken against the parties having clash. The community and respectable should also be involved for the prevention of crime against person by constituting Peace Committees at Thana Level. To achieve the target i.e prevention of abduction for ransom, the proposed mechanism is detailed below.

2. The administration of the school / concerned educational institution should not allow the students to go with any unconcerned person.

The cases against the concerned accused should be effectively pursued by the Police at its own level so as to seek maximum punishment with a view to give deterrence to others.

3. In case of acquittal from the cases, immediate appeal should be filed against the culprits. Similarly, if any of the accused is released on bail, the concerned SHO with the assistance of prosecution branch should arrange for filing cancellation petition.

4. As regards the safety of property from the thieves, dacoit etc, the measures to be adopted are suggested that effective patrolling, checking of suspected vehicles Chassis/Engine numbers should be got checked through Forensic Science Laboratory, introduction of parking system at specific places for vehicles, observance of movements of dacoits/robbers/car lifters etc and their harbourers in a secret manner, Re-activation of chowkidara system in cities and thekri pehra in towns for effectively controlling the theft through cable and local newspapers, to educate the people about their property including cattle, meetings/gathering should be arranged. The notables, peace committee and other influential persons should be motivated to promote and preserve the public order.

2.6 CONTINGENCY PLAN FOR MEETING EMERGENCIES AND ANNUAL EVENTS LIKE MUHAMMARM.

- ❖ On the important occasion, like Muharram-ul-Harram and other important events a security plan keeping in view the sensitivity of event/program is prepared.
- ❖ To ensure proper security arrangements concerned SDPOs, SHOs as well as undersigned personnel monitor the arrangements in the light of security plan.
- ❖ In this regard services of allied agencies i.e Special Branch, I.B, CTD, MI, Rescue 1122 and civil defense are also obtained.
- ❖ Further, services of Aman Committee are also obtained, specially during Muharram-ul-Harram, Chehnam and Majalis as well as other important religious events.

3 (ADMINISTRATIVE PLAN)

3.1.1 CHANGING THANA CULTURE

“Thana Culture” is often defined as culture of repression, abuse of authority, highhandedness, misbehavior, “Sifarish”, unsociability, pessimism, corruption, partisan, inefficiency, indifference and many other negative social attributes. Work ethics are considered to be non-transparent, out dated modes of operations/investigations and negative conduct. Lack of accountability and failure to communicate to public are additional factors contributing to the negative image of police. There are also question marks over forum and informal professionalism of Police Officers.

3.1.2 STEPS TAKEN FOR CHANGING THANA CULTURE

- ❖ Internal accountability.
- ❖ Community Policing.
- ❖ Community Policing Plan.

- ❖ Role of women Police officers in Policing.
- ❖ Free registration of FIR regime.
- ❖ Public Feedback System.
- ❖ Strict vigilance on SHOs for avoiding Touts and Kar-e-Khas.
- ❖ List of infamous touts have been prepared and sent to Police Stations for banning their entry without purpose.
- ❖ Visitor's Register is kept in custody of Santri, who keeps the record of every person who comes to the Police Station.
- ❖ Close liaison with the general public is kept to avoid Touts and Kar-e-Khas.

3.1.2(i) MODEL POLICE STATION.

- In 1st Phase Police Station Sadar Bhakkar was developed as Model Police Station in Bhakkar District which is functioning properly.
- Civil Work, Machinery, CCTV Cameras, Furniture, PROMIS etc have been completed.
- Web Site updated daily, e-complainants received, entered in Registers and redressed on daily basis.
- PROMIS functional.
- All FIRs/progress reports for the year, 2013-14 have been uploaded on Website.
- Main features of MPS i.e completion of record, improvement of cleanliness, behavioral changes, functioning of CPC etc; are being implemented in true spirit.
- Due to shortage of strength, the purposed force i.e. 94 officials could not be deployed. Maximum officials i.e. 770 from the available strength have been posted.

3.1.3 IMPROVING IMAGE OF POLICE.

- ❖ Police in Pakistan are undergoing a major credibility crisis. Police should change its behavior and attitude towards the public in order to improve its public image. In order to address this lack of credibility and public confidence in Police the following measures are being taken.
- ❖ Security of tenure of posting /transfer for a fixed term for one year at least.

- ❖ Open Katcheries are being held at DPO and SDPO level.
- ❖ Rescue 15 and Police Help Centers are functional round the clock.
- ❖ Achievements of Police to be publicized.
- ❖ Prompt/free registration of cases.
- ❖ Meaning full /visible patrolling to restore public confidence and minimize crime.
- ❖ Preservation of public peace and ensuring safety of the citizens.
- ❖ Ensuring culture of transparency.

3.1.4. COMMUNITY POLICING

The following steps have been taken in this regard.

- ❖ Establishment of Citizen Police Liaison Committee.
- ❖ Inauguration of Rescue-15 alongwith synchronization with vehicles tracking system.
- ❖ Website of Bhakkar Police www.bhakkarpolice.com
- ❖ Availability of all kind of vehicles and other data on Technical Assistant Unit.
- ❖ Organization of Masalehati committees.
- ❖ Organization of Aman committees.
- ❖ Open Katcheries by DPO, SDPOs and SHOs.
- ❖ Awareness campaign in school and colleges regarding Sodomy, Honour killing and Narcotics.

3.2 IMPROVING DISCIPLINE AND ACCOUNTABILITY:

- ❖ To improve displace / working of Police force many steps have been taken.
- ❖ Seminars were arranged.
- ❖ Refresher courses were held.
- ❖ Weekly parade is being held.
- ❖ In case of inefficiency, misconduct strict departmental action is initiated against the delinquent police officers/officials.
- ❖ The Police officers/officials shows good performance granted reward.

3.3 MERIT BASED RECRUITMENT:

- ❖ In the light of instructions received from higher forum the recruitment process will be completed.
- ❖ 100% transparency will be ensure.
- ❖ The measurement should be done keeping in view 100% merit.
- ❖ Females will be recruited according to their quota and their separate list will be maintained.

3.4 RAISING TRAINING STANDARDS.

- ❖ To improve the standard, following suggestions are recommended.
- ❖ Training program may be arranged keeping in view the need of latest requirements.
- ❖ Training should be imported by well educated/fully trained staff.
- ❖ The standard of residence /meal for trainees may also be improved.

3.5 WELFARE OF FORCE AND PROJECTS BEING IMPLEMENTED.

- ❖ Mess, Barracks and Police Stations are being repaired.
- ❖ All cases of Dowery, Shaheed claim, Scholarship is being submitted and a book-let regarding awareness of the constabulary is being circulated.
- ❖ Welfare Police mess is established in every Police Station and Police Lines.
- ❖ Family parks of Police Lines are being renovated.
- ❖ During plantation campaign more than 1500 plants have been planted.
- ❖ 5 kinds of sports are daily played in Police Lines.
- ❖ Gymnasium is well equipped and functioning very well.
- ❖ Personal meeting with the constabulary individually in the office and Police Stations even having dinner with the constabulary.

- ❖ Police regimental store is functioning on no profit and no loss basis.
- ❖ Barber is free and washer man gets only 10 rupees per uniform.
- ❖ Veteran's day is celebrated with all retired Police Officers.
