ANNUAL POLICING PLAN OF DISTRICT POLICE **RAHIMYARKHAN FOR THE YEAR 2015-2016**

1. BRIEF HISTORY/GEOGRAPHY OF DISTRICT

The District derives its name from its head quarters town Rahim Yar Khan. The previous name of this District was Naushera which was built in 1875 A.D by Fazal Elahi Halani on the ruins of the ancient Phul-Wadda during the sumra supremacy in Sindh. In the year 1881, the Railway Authorities desired to change the name of a Railway Station in Peshawar District. Consequently, Nawab Sadiq Khan-IV named it after his first son, Rahim Yar Khan” This District lies between 27-40 and 9-16 north longitudes and is surrounded on the north Muzaffar Garh District, on the east by Bahawalpur District, on the south by Jesilmir (India) and Ghotki District of Sindh Province and on the west by Rajanpur District. The total area of the District is 11880 square Kilometers. The total population of this district is 48,51,112 souls.

TOPOGRAPHY.

i) The District is divided into three main physical features i.e. (a) Riverain area (b) Canal irrigated area and (c) Desert area which is called Cholistan. The riverain area of the district lies close on the southern side of the Indus River mainly falling in the River Bed. The Canal irrigated area lies on the south and is separated by main Minchan Band. The approximate height of the irrigated area is 150 to 200 meters above the sea level. The 3rd art of the area which called Cholistan lies on the south of the irrigated tract upto the Indo Pak Border. The surface of the desert consists of a secession of Sand dunes rising at places to a height of 150 meters and covered with the vegetation peculiar to sandy tracts.

ii) The District Police adopted all possible preventive measures to prevent heinous crime, like looting of Bank, Petrol Pumps and Highway robberies. Comprehensive circular orders were prepared to regulate the police working. At Tehsil Headquarters flying squads were formed to prevent the occurrences in urban areas.

iii) The district possesses predominantly agricultural character. It is inhabited by two categories of people called as locals or "RIASTIS" the original inhabitants of the defunct Bahawalpur State (60%) and the "SETTLERS" (40%) fertile lands have much attraction for settlers from other parts of the country. The locals are mostly residing geographically in the northern part of the district i.e. around the Railway line and upto the river while the settlers are mostly residing in the urban area or the South of Railway line extending to the Cholistan.

iv) The structure of the society even at village level is promiscuous. The illiteracy and moral corruption is rampant. The elopement and love affairs are

frequent due to non observance of PARDA particularly in rural areas. The cases are contested at investigation level, but normally are compounded in courts. The bulk of murders and attempted murders arise out of the infidelity of women and land disputes.

v) The District has a considerable industrial potential Lever Brothers Limited, Leghari Beverages, Hye Sons Sugar Mills, Machi Goth United Sugar Mills, Fauji Fertilizer Company, Ahmed Ghee Mills and a large number of cotton ginning factories and oil mills are functioning since long in this district. The establishment of these industrial units added labour problems to the already existing agrarian disputes but the over all situations remained under control through vigilance and timely intervention.

vi) The overall complex of this district is feudal because the landlords enjoy a lot of influence. The disputes and other cases are dictated as the chieftains of the tribes desires. Consequently, the results in courts are also affected.

vii) The people of this district are generally religious mind and followers of different schools of thought. The religious leaders exercise considerable influence over the people. The religious controversy sometimes creates law and order situation for the district administration. The activities of Tehrik Islamia Pakistan and Millat-e-Islamia Pakistan were closely and constantly kept under surveillance and monitoring.

viii) The national Highway (Karachi-Lahore-Peshawar) passes through the district over 160 kms with a large number of link roads, where thousands of vehicles ply round the clock. The poor condition of metal road also contributed toward traffic accidents. Similarly Railway line length of 164 KMs passes through with the main stops at Liaquatpur, Khanpur, Rahim Yar Khan and Sadiqabad, In

order to avoid any acts of terrorism all SDPOs/ SHOs have been directed to have a vigil eye on the activities of Anti Social elements. By the grace of Almighty Allah no incident of sabotage took place so far in this district.

2. OPERATION PLAN MAY INCLUDE AREAS AS UNDER:-.

**i. Maintenance Of Public Order Drive Against Criminals
Combating Terrorism**

The District police by using its all available resources is trying its utmost to deny the occurrences of heinous crime and to control law and order situation. Systematic patrolling has been arranged round the clock to ensure the police presence at every corner. Whenever any occurrence of heinous nature takes place the police of the nearest police station reaches the spot and give hot pursuits to the criminals and provides safety cordon to avoid the recurrence of such crime. All B.Cs addicted to heinous crime has been identified and are under police surveillance. The crime against property although has shown downward trend yet the fact remains that the district police acquitted with its duties in a responsible manner and more recoveries were made. The criminals who indulged in this crime are outsiders and infiltrates from long zigzags of district Ghotki and Jacobabad of Sindh Province, Soan Miani and Riverian Area of River Indus of Rajanpur district. In order to combat the crime and criminals the possible routes of influx and efflux of out-laws, systematic patrolling and by especially established mobile

squads were introduced. The timings at which the out-laws used to commit heinous crime were calculated and stringent measures were taken to prevent the occurrences of heinous crime. At present, there is no threat to law and order situation in this district.

ii. Security of Key installations foreigners.

The Security of foreigner's separate compromenain SOP has been made and circulated to all concerned. Moreover police duty deployed on each foreigner project residence and key, installations. Especially during foreigner movement elite scored be provided.

iii Free registration of cases.

As per order , six (6) registration center have been established in district Rahim Yar Khan and Inspector Legal posted to perform the assigned duties, The details are given here under:-

iv) Fair and speedy investigation

The investigation staff under the closed supervision of SP investigation investigated the case fair and speedy and sent to court.

v) Prevention of crime.

In order to achieve control over violent crime against person i.e. Murder, Attempted Murder etc, timely preventive measures are initiated, against inimical parties even in case of minor disputes. Moreover, in families where old enmity subsists, the parties are persuaded to compromise through conciliatory efforts of the respectable and local public preventatives.

The details of steps/remedial measures adopted by the District Police are the same as already mentioned above. All SDPOs/SHOs have been directed to ensure the practical implementation of these measures so that the positive outcome/ desired results are achieved.

The District police by using its all available resources is trying its utmost to decrease the heinous crime and to control law and order situation. Systematic patrolling has been arranged round the clock to ensure the police presence at vast area. Whenever any occurrence of heinous nature takes place, the local police reaches the spot immediately with mobile C.R.O. van and gives

hot pursuit to the criminals. All B.Cs addicted to heinous crime have been identified and graded as target offenders. They have been made to face proceedings under preventive laws and are under police surveillance. The crime against property although has shown upward trend yet the fact remains that the district police performed efficiently and more recoveries have been made. Most of the perpetrators of heinous crime belong from kacha area of district Ghotki/Jacobabad/Kashmore of Sindh and of Rajanpur District, Punjab. In order to combat the crime and criminals the possible routes of influx and efflux of out-laws have been plugged by way of systematic patrolling, picketing at vital points and by especially mobile squads. The crime was fought in the light of timings and vulnerability of area.

3. Administrative plan may include area as below:-

i) The primary strategy and device for building up a sound public image of the Police Force is overall concrete and tangible out-put, significant achievements in prevention and detection of crime widely splashed in the media, highly decent and attitude for the redressal of their grievances in matters relating to Police for which officers and Jawans of the district Police have been thoroughly briefed with elaborated instructions. The delinquents shall be dealt with strict departmental action commensurate with gravity of the violative conduct.

In this modern age, it is not possible for the police to act in isolation distanced from community at large for the achievements of its paramount objectives of maintenance of law and order and elimination of crime from the society. Securing public cooperation and help from the NGOs and Welfare Organization in order to root out crime, arrest of POs/CAs elimination of Narcotics, recovery of illicit arms requires well concerted efforts and energetic action with the backing of the public and NGOS.

RESIYRCES NEEDED FOR THE FULFILLMENT OF PLAN

(a) **Increase Of Strength**

Existing strength of the district police is inadequate to meet the challenges of crime and law and order situation of a huge district with enormous and over increasing population of about 48 lac.

(b) **Financial resources.**

Shortfall of financial and other resources has already been specifically discussed above in detail. It is obvious enough that with the increase of strength, there shall be corresponding increase in the budget, transport, communication, arms and ammunition and construction of Police Station and Police Officers buildings.

© **COMPUTERIZATION.**

In the prevailing circumstance, the utility importance of computer has been increased, so much so that, it has become a basic need for maintenance of record and immediate availability of data, references required for disposal of matters urgent nature. It is recommended that the computer facility may be provided upto police station level with its link at district, Province and central level.

RECOVERY OF ILLICIT WEAPONS.

Special campaign for de-deionization is already in progress. The same shall continue and be pursued with ever more vigorous and concerted efforts.

CONTROL OVER TRAFFICE ACCIDENTS.

fatal Following measures have been adopted for effective control over accidents:-

1. Action against rush and reckless driving.
2. Cancellation of Driving Licenses and route permits in case of fatal accidents.

WELFARE OF POLICE PERSONNEL

With a view to achieve the highest excellence of efficiency and performance of the Police personnel, the following steps are proposed to be taken for the welfare of the force.

1. Police Officers are on duty for 24 hours as compared to the civil servants. Therefore the pay scales for Police Department may be separated from that the civil servants with reasonable increase in the pay. This would motivated the Police Officers to work harder and with honesty.
2. Police Officers from Constable to Inspector be provided with food from Police Mess instead of Ration Allowance as practiced in Army, FC and Coast Guards. This would reduce the mental disturbance of preparing of preparing food, which is time consuming.
3. Police Officers form the rank of ASI to Inspector be provided motorcycle with mounted wireless sets after completion of their trainings. These motorcycles be allotted to theses officers with permission to retain them on eve of their transfers. The cost of these motorcycles be charged from the concerned officers with reasonable installments. When the cost is completed, the motorcycle should be registered on their names. This would reduce the problem of transportation in the department.

4. Police residential colonies should be constructed throughout the Province and Police Officers be accommodated. As an alternate, houses, flats and hostels may be rented to accommodate these officers for the time being. This would create peace of mind in Police Officers towards residential problems.
5. An amount of 20 percent from the total lay out of recoveries from arms and ammunitions, stolen properties and traffic fines should be deposited in a district account. This amount should be distributed among Officers of the district Police from the rank of Constable to District Police Officer at the end of each month. This would provide incentives for officers to work harder towards recoveries and enhance efficiency.
6. Forensic Science laboratories may be established at Range Headquarters under supervision of the DIG (P) and a central Forensic Science laboratory may be established at provincial level. This would provide better access to laboratory facilities and reduce the usual delay in diagnosis.
7. Prosecution Branch at District level may be reestablished with reasonable increase in the strength of Inspectors Legal and DSP Legal. An Inspector Legal at every Police station and Inspector Circle office should be appointed to provide legal advice to promote efficiency in investigation etc.
8. Each Police Station be provided with computers to computerize their record and have faster access to it as and when needed.
9. Police Monitoring Cell may be established at all District offices under supervision of DSP/ASP to monitor the working of the local Police rapid disposal of investigation in cases.
10. A public Relation office may be established at district level to improve liaison between the Police journalists.
11. District Sports and Welfare Offices should be established at district level appointing a Gazetted Officer as in charge.
12. Police Officers from the rank of Constable may be granted advances / loans without for: House building (ii) Motorcar (iii). Motorcycle (iv). Marriages of Children and (V) Education.

13. Hairdresser and Washman may be increased and free services be provided to police personnel.
14. Mess Cook, helper, Watermen and Sweepers needed to be increased Police Station-wise.
15. Separate quota for police children in educational institutes may be fixed with reasonable concessions.
16. As admissible to the army, FC and other force Police Officers / Officials may be issued travel concession vouchers for Air and Train.
17. Ten percent quota may be fixed for police children for recruitment as Constables and ASI in the department.
18. District Sports and welfare offices should be established at district level appointing a Gazetted officer as in charge.
19. Police Officers from the rank of Inspector to District Police Officer are accountable in their working while ASIs and SIs are exempted.
20. Every police station should be provided with at least one reliable single cabin pick-up vehicles (Toyota) with wireless set mounted. This should ensure faster access to a scene and better relief could be expected.
21. In addition to the existing telephone a separate telephone for incoming calls only to ensure better contact with the Police Station and general public.
22. Police Personal should be provided with technical training before retirement so that they are able to earn a respectable living after retirement.
23. Three private buses may be provided to pick and drop the school/college going children of Police Officers/Officials.
24. Suitable arrangements need to be made for provision of status wise accommodation at the time of retirement to junior and senior Police Officers as prevalent in Pakistan Army.
25. The pay of Police Constable in working district police may be made as per with the Constable in Patrolling Police and the Motorway Police to vanish the indiscriminatioin.

PRE-REQUISITES TO MAKE THE PLAN A SUCCESS **POLICE STRENGTH.**

In the recent past, the Government of the Punjab has sanctioned more vacancies of Constables in District Rahimyar Khan, if these vacant seats are fulfilled, the district police has no residential accommodation in shape of barracks etc. to shelter the newly recruited force. Moreover, the provisions of bath rooms and latrines will also be necessitated to cope with the situation alongwith reasonable messes and canteen. For this purpose, the construction at least 6 barracks with attached bath rooms/latrines would be required. Out of which two barracks and 4 bath rooms would be constructed out of welfare fund during this year.

CONSTRUCTION OF POLICE STATIONS AND ONE POLICE POST.

At present, PSs City Divisions, , Manthar, Air Port, Iqbal Abad Abe-Hayat and PP Feroza are lodged in rented buildings, which is creating many administrative problems. In coming years construction of these police stations and post would be required.

CONSTRUCTION OF FULLY EQUIPPED INTER-PROVINCIAL CHECK-POSTS.

Keeping in view the increasing trend of crime in the Inter-Provinces areas, the case of two Inter Provincial Check-Posts fully equipped with arms and ammunition, computers and wireless set up has been moved. These posts will be required at Kot Sabzal and Daoowala.

PROVISION OF MOTOR BOATS.

To combat with the crime in the riverain area, at least 12 motor boats/launches are required by the District Police Rahimyar Khan. Such supply will culminate into the minimizing of the crime to the lowest in that area.

SUPPLY OF TRANSPORT.

i. District Police Rahimyar khan was provided with official vehicles for their use by the police employees while on their duties, but this existing strength is not sufficient enough to cope with requirements and it needs gradual replacement with 30 % to 40% on yearly basis.

No. of vehicles need replacement in year 2015 = 20

ii. All the heavy districts of the Province have been provided with mobile canteens but this district is facing sever handicaps in the supply of food to the jawans and officers in multifarious like visits of VVIP etc.

iii. A.P.C. = At present, two A.P.Cs. are available to combat the criminals in the katcha area but both of them are now become antiques and pose serious handicaps during operations in Kacha area. Replacement of both the A.P.Cs. is requested on priority.

METAL DETECTORS AND WALK THROUGH GATES.

In the modern age, the importance of metal detectors and walk through gate can not be denied in any manner. At least, 340 metal detectors and 4 walk through gates may kindly be sanctioned for the district police.

BOMB DISPOSAL SQUAD.

To eliminate acts of terrorism and sabotage, District Police Rahimyar khan would need at least one bomb disposal equipment. It is requested that necessary steps for its provision may be sanctioned for this district at the earliest.

i. Financial aid to Widows

During the current year, special attention was paid to the welfare of the force and especially welfare of the 66 widows of late police employees. In

toto, an amount of Rs.60000/- is being paid to all the widows on monthly basis and this total amount counts to the tune of Rs.3300000/- per Annum.

ii. Welfare of widows of martyrs of police force.

This important aspect of the welfare of the force was never ignored and on the eve of Eid-DAY, 23rd March an amount of Rs.90,0000/- was distributed and likewise an amount of Rs.30000/- was given to the each widows of the late employees, too.

iii. Establishment of Police welfare school on the pattern of beachonhouse school system.

In the light of orders by the PPO, a beautiful building surrounded by a boundary wall has been established just closer to the PS Sadar Rahimyar Khan. The spade work to start with the school has been completed and it is hoped that the admissions for the first session will take place during the next educational year. An amount of Rs.50 lacs has been spent over the assignment. This establishment will prove its worth in the education of the kids of the employees for their development as builders of Pakistan.

iv. Educational scholarships for the children of employees.

During the current year, an amount of Rs.600000/- was paid to 146 school going children of the police employees which has boosted up the morale of the force and encouraged the students to achieve marvelous goals in future also.

COMBAT AGAINST TERRORISM.

In order to achieve control over terrorism, the following measures have been adopted:-

1. Vigilant eye on the activities of the activities of the activist of the proscribed organization i.e. SSP, TNFJ, SMP and LT.
2. Deployment of force at Mosque/Imam Bargahs and Churches etc.
3. Updating the list of Afghan Trained Boys.

4. Action against the harbourers of these activities under the amended ATA ordinance 2001.
5. Deployment of force in plain clothes to watch over the activities of the suspect at the vital installation and important public areas.
6. Deployment of force for security of Mosques, Imam Barghas and Churches.
7. Constitution of special Team for the arrest of Sectarian POs/Terrorists.
8. Provision of gunmen to the persons on Hit-List.
9. Updating of the record of property dealers, regarding the persons who obtain rented houses through them. Like-wise updating of record of Hotel/Sarai visitors.

SECTARIAN HARMONY.

- I. Close liaison and contact is being maintained with the prominent leaders of all sects.
- II. Holding of regular meeting with the Members of District peace Committee including the notables of all sects.
- III. Special steps are taken to ensure the sectarian harmony for effective security arrangements especially during the Moharam-ul-Harram and all other religious occasions.
- IV. Equal and even handed treatment by the District Administration with all sects the legal issues.
- V. Implementation of Loud-Speaker and Amplifier Ordinance.

At the end, the cooperation and coordination of elected member of legislated assemblies, CO, intelligence Agencies (civil and army) and judiciary may culminate into the success of this effort for the years 2014-2015 and Rahimyar Khan District may become a symbol of peace & tranquility for all the times to come.
