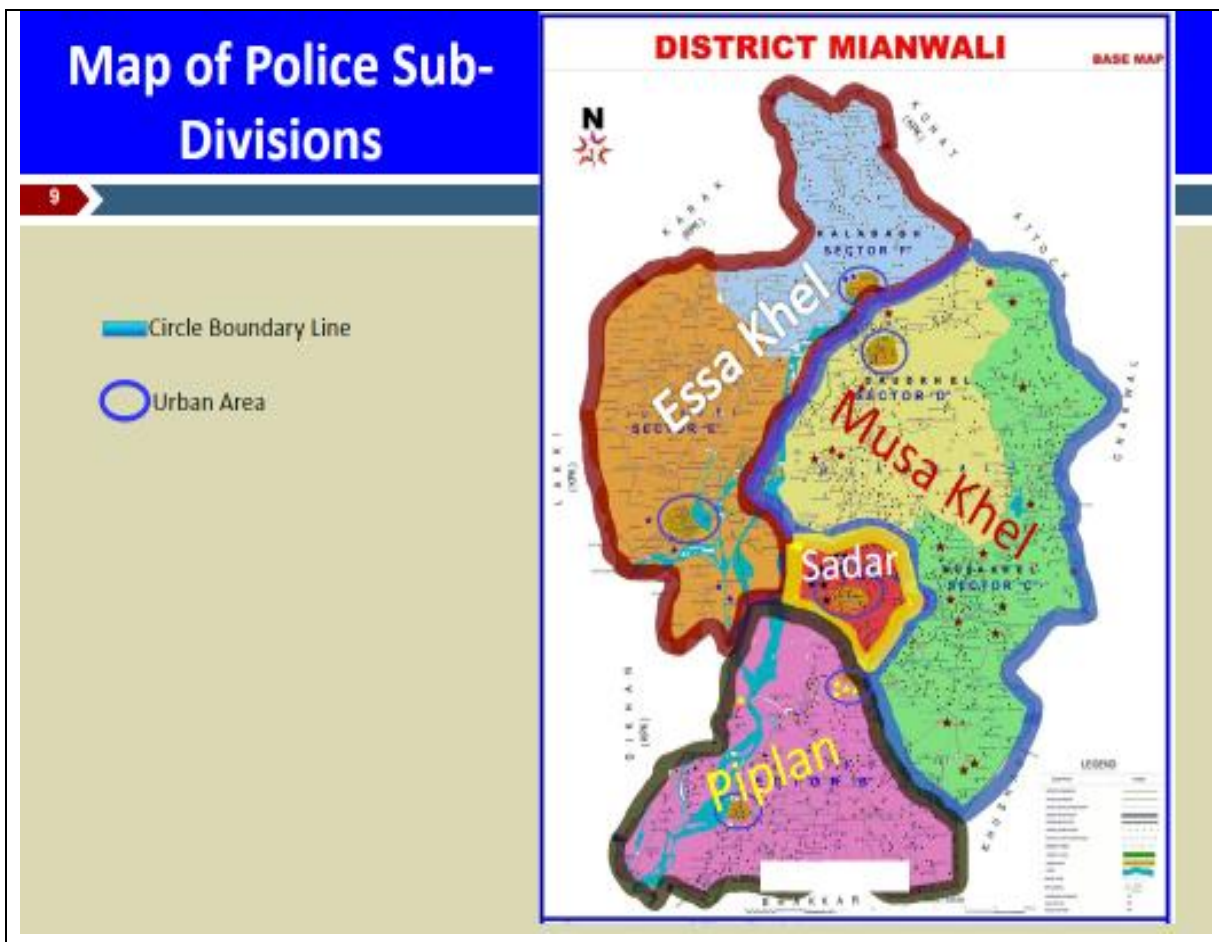
## INTRODUCTION

Article 10(4) of the Police Order 2002 envisages the formulation of Annual District Policing Plan. The plan shall include objectives of policing, financial resources likely to be available during the year, targets and mechanism for achieving those targets. As a statutory requirement, “**Annual Policing Plan 2022-23**” is supposed to be submitted to the competent authority for its approval. In the interest of the comprehensive approach to law enforcement, we have also been guided by the need to ensure that counter terrorism role of Punjab Police would not detract from its ability to meet the broader responsibility entrusted to it for maintenance of law and order in the province.

## DISTRICT DETAIL

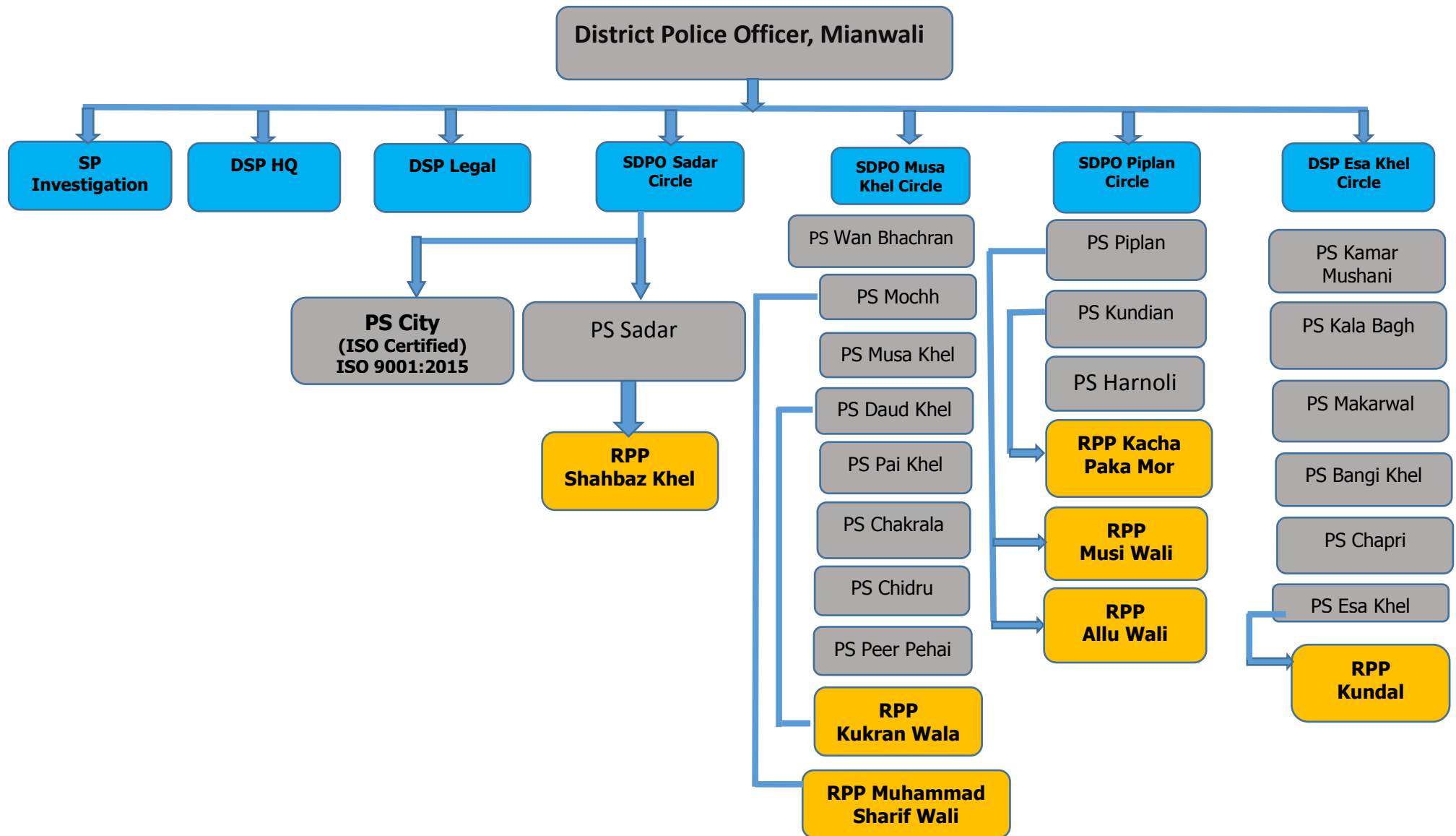
### Brief introduction Describing main Responsibilities/ area etc:

- Mianwali was a Tehsil of District Bannu Province KPK and in year 1901 **Mianwali District** was established, comprises of three Sub-Divisions namely Mianwali, Esa Khel & Piplan. However, there are 4 Police Sub-divisions namely Essa Khel, Musa Khel, Piplan and Sadar Mianwali.
- The district is spread over an area of 6975 Sq Kms and according to last census the population of district Mianwali is 1.546 million. District Mianwali is a bordering District of Punjab Province and has common borders with District Kohat, Karak, Laki Marwat and D.I.Khan of (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa).



## ORGANOGRAM FROM DPO TO SHO

District Mianwali consists of 4 Sub-Divisions, i.e., Saddar Mianwali, Musa Khel, Piplan and Esa Khel. There are 19 Police Stations and 07 Riverine Police Posts. The Organizational set up of the District Police Mianwali is as under: -

- Many famous personalities i.e., Imran Ahmed Khan (ex-cricketer & ex -Prime Minister of Pakistan), Maulana Abdul Sattar Khan Niazi, Malik Ameer Muhammad Khan, Ex-Governor of west Pakistan, Atta Ullah Khan Esa Khelvi (folk singer), Misbah-ul-Haq (ex-cricketer of Pakistan team) belong to District Mianwali.
- Due to low literacy rate, poverty, unemployment as well as unfavourable socio-political culture of the district compel the criminal to commit crime. When these factors are seen together with the

contiguity of Mianwali with D.I.Khan, Lakki Marwat, Karak & Kohat District the overall set of these features not only influences crime pattern but also generates the trend of religious radicalization / extremism / sectarian unrest and no wonder violence on these accounts has been witnessed in the district from time to time.

Similarly in order to achieve the optimal results and keeping in view the provincial priorities; the offenders, who have been arrested or convicted in heinous crimes during the last five years, will be specifically targeted.

### **MAJOR CHALLENGES AND HURDLES BEING FACED IN OFFICIAL WORKING IN DISTRICT MIANWALI.**

District Police Mianwali also facing acute shortage resources like other Govt. Departments which causes hindrance and adversely affects the police performance detail of shortage / hurdles are as under: -

<b>Major challenges</b>	<b>Hurdles in official working</b>
<b>Strength</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The available strength of District Police is 1492 and shortage is 232 as per sanctioned strength. Infact, as per optimum ratio (1 for 450) the shortage of police personnel is 2098. To meet the requirement of district police Mianwali for fulfilment of the plan and to achieve required result, this deficiency of strength is required to be fulfil as earliest.</li> </ul>
<b>Transport</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Transport of this district police is insufficient in terms of number and many vehicles which are on road are in shabby and poor condition, which requires maintenance time and again. This mean, old model vehicles enhanced the cost of repair &amp; maintenance. Thus, keeping in view the sensitive installation as well as prevailing wave of terrorism, needs effective patrolling, which required more transport / vehicles to prevent any untoward incident and to save the cost of repair &amp; maintenance.</li> </ul>
<b>Traffic Accidents</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Due to poor condition of road infrastructure in the district, hardly any traffic sense amongst common populace prevails. Hence, to prevent the road accidents, speed cameras and strength of traffic</li> </ul>

	police at Tehsil level should be materialized to cope the need of hour.
<b>Accommodation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Existing capacity of accommodation is insufficient to meet the needs. Hence, more accommodation at Police Lines, Mianwali is badly needed.</li> </ul>
<b>Non-availability of Sui Gas at Police Lines, Mianwali</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It is also badly needed to meet the needs of inhabitants of police lines as well as police personnel.</li> </ul>
<b>Issues with Investigative Work</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lack of professional capacity to make best use of evidence available at crime scene</li> <li>• Reliance on conventional means of investigation (extracting confessions through physical and mental torture)</li> <li>• Lack of training regarding use of modern technology for investigations</li> <li>• Non-availability of modern investigative tools and corresponding training/capacity building</li> <li>• Hence, it is imperative that I.Os should be equipped with modern investigation tools &amp; gadgets to curb the crimes effectively and timely.</li> </ul>
<b>Obsolete Building and Structure of DPO Office</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Building of DPO office is outdated and obsolete. Hence, required new building with spacious room. Therefore, it is requested that new building of DPO Office Mianwali may be established.</li> </ul>
