1. Introduction:


i. <u>A brief Introduction of Plan:</u>

This Policing Plan for the year 2023-2024 has been framed by the District Police, Toba Tek Singh as envisaged in Article 32(4) of Police Order 2002. This document chiefly aims at providing a peaceful atmosphere to the masses so that the society may have a sense of peace and security. It goes without saying that policing in modern times is a complex task. The days of the retroactive policing are over and a new era of proactive policing has commenced. Therefore this annual policing plan has been framed keeping in view the geographical location of the district, its essential features, analysis of the past five years crime along with wide ranging discussions, debates, seminars, interviews, consultations and meetings held with a cross sections of society. This plan adequately reflects the trend of crime and the needs and expectations of the community. Not only the measurable targets have been identified, key actions and mechanism to achieve these targets have also been mentioned under each head of crime. Notwithstanding these limitations, district police Toba Tek Singh is determined to strive to the utmost for realization of these targets so that qualitative and meaningful policing is provided to the people on whose behalf we undertook these onerous responsibilities. We plan to work in close cooperation with law abiding citizens and representatives of Public for establishment of rule of law as well as arrest of crime and the criminals. We substantially depend on public support by bringing about qualitative change in the attitude of the police particularly the staff posted at the police stations so that our struggle against, both crime and the criminals is undertaken with necessary strength and support of the people. I am confident that we will deliver in accordance with law & to the expectations of the people as I have faith in my officers and subordinates for adequately meeting this challenge.

ii. District Detail:

District Toba Tek Singh has **04** Police Sub-Divisions, **12** Police Stations and **04** Police Posts, having 04 Revenue Sub-Divisions comprising **807,238** Acres area. It was a subdivision of District Faisalabad before it was given the status of District on **01-07-1982**. District Toba Tek Singh is bordered by Faisalabad District to the East, Khanewal District to the West, Sahiwal District to the South and Jhang to the North. The District Police is all set to deliver by realigning its orientation and attitude to conform to the new good governance parameters and aspirations of the people.

2. <u>District Objectives of Policing:-</u>

- 1. To minimize the crime rate through prevention & detection.
- 2. To improve the operations of Police Department through the acquisition of equipments, technology and recruitment of high quality manpower in the force.
- 3. To promote "Community Policing".
- 4. To effect maximum arrest of Proclaimed Offenders, Court Absconders and Military Deserters.
- 5. To prevent the drugs trafficking.
- 6. To ensure security at all important events including Moharram-ul-Haram, Eids and Elections etc.
- 7. To develop intelligence to bust criminal gangs.
- 8. To de-weaponize the society by confiscating illegal weapons.
- 9. To ensure compliance of Hon'ble Court Orders.
- 10. To ensure safe custody of the under trial prisoners from jails to Courts and Courts to jail.
- 11. To ensure maximum recovery of stolen/robbed goods, motorcycles, motorcars and other vehicles.
- 12. To ensure smooth flow of traffic throughout the district and to minimize major and minor roadside accidents.
- 13. Safety of Educational Institutions.
- 14. To provide necessary legal support to other departments in the discharge of their duties.
- 15. To assist the Government during different kinds of natural clamities.
- 16. To ensure Police-Prosecution coordination for effective prosecution of criminal cases.

1. Initiatives:-

i) <u>Citizen Feedback System.</u>

The Citizen Feedback Cell has been established to gather feedback from all the clients of the District Police, so that the public grievances against the police officials can be redressed. This system tends to enhance the level of service delivery, accountability and fair dealing by the police personnel and will generate realization on the part of general people that their complaints against the malpractices of police officials are being responded and their grievances are redressed expeditiously.

ii) <u>Empowering people through communication and respect.</u>

Open Door Policy, No Chit System, no visiting cards and no visiting hours. Now, complainant comes into direct contact with DPO in case of any grievance.

iii) <u>Open Ketchehri.</u>

Open Ketchehri at DPO office from 12:00 (noon) to 01:00 (noon) has been made a regular feature where the grievances of Public are heard and redressed as per law.

iv) Establishment of central 15 control room and Police vehicles tracking system.

In order to ensure the quickest response from Police against crime, a Central 15 Control Centre, equipped with police mobile vehicles, tracking system has been established at the District Police Offices Complex, Toba Tek Singh. For this purpose, emergency cell centre system has been installed at Control Room. Moreover, 32 vehicles have been equipped with tracker units.

v). <u>Accountability through awareness – guidelines for general public for criminal</u> <u>Investigation.</u>

These guidelines have been developed by Toba Tek Singh police to enhance the knowledge regarding the procedure and process of police investigation and to create awareness about their legal rights. These guidelines are imparted to the complainant alongwith copy of every FIR registered in the district.

vi) <u>Initiatives taken up for improving Investigation.</u>

For improving the quality of investigation, a digital lab has been established at DPO Office. Analysis of Call data records of mobile phones to trace out complicated cases is the major function of this Lab. This Lab also has a digital database for stolen vehicles.

vii) <u>Skill Development Centre.</u>

A training facility including a class room equipped with multimedia and other modern facilities has been established at Police Lines, T.T.Singh. This Skill Development Centre has the seating capacity of 34 persons. After its establishment, many courses have been conducted at this centre to enhance the professional capacity of Investigation Officers and Moharrirs.

viii) <u>Digital Uniform Store.</u>

A new digitalized uniform store has been established at the Police Lines. All the transactions of this Uniform Store are recorded in the computer through especially designed software which has ensured proper and timely distribution of uniform articles among the police personnel of District Police Toba Tek Singh.

ix) <u>Computerization.</u>

A computer centre is established in each Police Station. A Computerized Complaint Cell, with complaint management system at district level is inter-connected with the provincial offices through Web. Official record of police officials has been computerized.

x) <u>Merit Based Recruitment.</u>

Monitoring of all the stages of recruitment i.e. Forms evaluation, physical measurement, endurance test, written test and interview of the aspiring candidates is conducted by a Higher Level Recruitment Board headed by a DIG of Police nominated by CPO, Punjab, Lahore. Police officials with unimpeachable service record are deputed in the whole recruitment process. The principles of transparency, accountability and merit are followed strictly.

xi) <u>Establishment of Police Khidmat Markaz.</u>

In order to facilitate the general public "Police Khidmat Markaz" has been established in DPO Office and the same is functioning properly. The facilities of issuing Learner Driving Permit, Police Character Certificate, Verification of Vehicles, issuing copy of FIR are provided to the public under one roof.

xii) Establishment of Police Khidmat Counters.

"Police Khidmat Counters" have been established in DHQ Toba & THQs Kamalia, Pir Mahal & Gojra in order to facilitate the general public.

xiii) <u>Functioning of Police Khidmat Mobile Van.</u>

In order to facilitate the general public nearest to their doors "Police Khidmat Mobile Van" has been started in this district and the same is working properly.

xiv) Establishment of Police Driving Training Schools.

Police Driving Training Schools have been established in District Police Lines, Toba Tek Singh, Tehsil Gojra & Pir Mahal. **1670** individuals got training from the Schools.

xv) <u>Establishment of Digital Lab.</u>

A Digital Lab has been established adjacent to DPO Office, for analyzing Call Data Record (CDR), tracing the Proclaimed Offenders (P.Os) and maintain the record of CRO Branch.

xvi). Establishment of Super Model Police Stations.

PS City Toba, Rajana, City Gojra and Chuttiana have been designated as "Super Model Police Stations" in this district to facilitate the public in an efficient manner and due courtesy to the visitors.

xvii). Implementation of Cost Free SIPS.

xviii). Welfare of Police Force.

Several projects of welfare of police force have been completed in which Renovation of Mess Hall, construction of new recreation room and Gymnasium, establishment of Utility Stores, new barracks for officials, construction of Quarter Guards, repair of metallic road within the Police Lines are of worth importance. A jogging track has been constructed in district police lines; Home grown Mess kitchen garden; massive scale renovation of police petrol pump has been made. Further Bahaar Officers Hostel has also been constructed at Police Lines Toba Tek Singh.

5. <u>Comments by the DPO:</u>

A major development in District Toba Tek Singh is the passing of 02 Motorways through the District. This has resulted in increased number of fatal accidents and robberies by virtue of easy escape ways through both Motorways.
